All Meetings:

Coverage: Each POQC member is compensated for their participation in MOQC meetings. See included meeting list.

Time: Time is rounded to the nearest 15-minute increment.

Payment Details: POQC payments go out on a quarterly basis. (Jan-March, April-June, July-Sept, Oct-Dec)

Meeting hours are logged in a program called QuickBooks Time by the MOQC Coordinating Center by the end of each quarter. Expertise Payment:

Gas Mileage:
\$0.725/mile

In-Person Meetings:

Gas Mileage: The cost of gas mileage for travel to and from meetings from home address is covered and included with quarterly payments. Project managers will calculate this automatically for POQC members in attendance.

Hotels: For meetings/events that start before 10:00 am or end after 7:00 pm, POQC members with a drive of more than 2 hours can request a hotel room. Typically, MOQC pays the cost of approved hotels for POQC members. Hotel rooms can only be reimbursed with prior written approval in specific situations.

Food: Meals will be provided during meetings that coincide with meal times. This includes breakfast for morning meetings, lunch for afternoon meetings, and dinner for evening meetings. Please communicate dietary restrictions in advance. Food can only be reimbursed with prior written approval in specific situations.

The University does not withhold taxes from payments, so individuals are responsible for managing their own taxes. Earnings over \$600 from any University department are reported to the IRS, and a 1099 form will be issued; for further assistance, individuals can contact 734-615-2000 (opt 3, opt 1).
